


About B.Sc. Optometry

The Chaithanya Institute of Optometry & Vision Sciences, Trivandrum is pleased to offer a 4-year undergraduate B.Sc. Optometry programme which is a comprehensive program designed to equip students with the knowledge and skills needed to excel in the dynamic and rewarding field of Optometry.

The B.Sc. Optometry course includes three years of academic training and one year of compulsory rotational internship in various specialty departments of the Hospital.

The course has approximately 240 working days in a year with a minimum of 6 hours per day for theory and practical sessions ie 1450 working hours, per year (inclusive of examination). After the third year, the students have to undergo one-year rotatory compulsory internship in various eye specialty clinics in the hospital. The course is approved by Government of Kerala and has been granted provisional affiliation by the Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur (KUHS).



Roles and Responsibilities : OPTOMETRY

Who is an Optometrist ?

Optometrists are primary health care practitioners of the eye and visual system who provide comprehensive eye and vision care, which includes refraction and dispensing, detection/diagnosis and co-management of disease in the eye and the rehabilitation of conditions of the visual system.

Job Opportunities

The job sectors for optometrist can be divided into the following areas:

1. Corporate sector

1. Examination, prescribing, management, and dispensing of various optical aids – spectacles, contact lens, low vision aids/assistive devices – for people of all age groups.
2. Diagnosis, management/co-management of ocular and related systemic diseases/conditions for people of all age groups.
3. Diagnosis and management of Non Strabismic/strabismic binocular vision anomalies through non-invasive procedures.
4. Eye care services at community level – examples: school screening, cataract screening, glaucoma screening, diabetic retinopathy screening, occupational optometry, Doorstep eye care.
5. Optometric/ Genetic counselling on eye care of patients with partial sight, including colour blindness and hereditary eye diseases.
6. Public education on eye care, ocular hygiene, nutrition and environmental effects on the eye.
7. Examination and visual rehabilitation of patients with low vision and profound visual impairment.

Laboratory

The Optics Laboratory is the cornerstone of practical learning in our Optometry college and providing students with hands-on experience in understanding and applying optical principles essential to vision science. Equipped with advanced instruments such as spectrometers, Newton's ring apparatus, sodium and mercury vapor lamps, and a variety of concave and convex lenses and mirrors, the lab enables students to explore the behavior of light, lens properties, and image formation in a controlled environment.

ADMISSION PROCESS

Criteria of Eligibility for Admission

To verify the following

1. Holders of Persons of Indian Origin (PIO) Cards/Overseas Citizens of India (OCI) will also be treated at par with Indian citizens for the limited purpose of admission. **To examine whether they need to be reckoned as NRIs for fees collection purposes.**



2. Candidates should have passed Higher Secondary examination conducted by the Board of Higher Secondary Education, Kerala or examination equivalent thereto as approved by Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur. The candidates should have separate minimum pass marks for Physics, Chemistry and Biology and 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology put together.
3. The candidate should be 17 years of age to be eligible for admission.

Mode of selection to the Course

The Chaithanya Institute of Optometry & Vision Sciences has been permitted to admit 25 students for the B.Sc. Optometry course 2025

Government Seats: 13

Merit seats against which the Director, LBS Centre makes allotment are called 'Government Seats'. 50% of the seats are reserved under Govt. Merit Quota to be allotted by LBS Centre for Science & Technology.

Mode of Selection/Admission to Management Seats

Seats other than Government seats are called Management seats.

No. of Seats: 12 of which 3 seats (15% of total seat) reserved for NRI category)

Selection: Duly filled online application form must be submitted along with the required documents. Students will be selected based on their performance in the 12th standard for Science group. Post counselling, students can undergo the admission procedure.

Duration permitted for completion of the Course

As stated above, the duration of the course is 3 years + 1 year of internship. However, the maximum permitted period for completion of the course will be 8 years including internship. (Double the duration of the course period.)



Attendance

- Each student is required to put in at least 80% attendance in each academic year for theory and practical subjects separately. This requirement is mandatory and cannot be reduced under any circumstances including maternity/medical leave.
- Each candidate shall complete the prescribed course satisfactorily in order to be eligible to appear for the examination. The Head of the Institution should submit Attendance Performance Certificate (APC) for each candidate on the satisfactory completion of the course.
- Absence from classes shall be permitted only with valid leave letter counter signed by Parent/Guardian and Warden-in-charge.
- Medical Leave application should be submitted along with Medical Certificate.





Condonation of shortfall in attendance

- Condonation, up to a maximum of 10 per cent can be granted for shortage of attendance on genuine grounds for subjects (theory/practical/both), once during the entire course period. The Principal is empowered to grant the condonation on recommendation by the Head(s) of the department under intimation to KUHS along with the prescribed fee.
- Along with the application for Registration in the Examination, the Principal shall give an Undertaking that the candidate has not availed this exemption previously.
- A Register showing the details of Condonation granted shall be maintained in the Office of the Principal which shall be subject to verification by Officers authorized by the University.



Information to Candidates – Rules & Regulations

All students admitted to the institute will be governed by the rules and regulations that are prescribed from time to time.

College Timings and Attendance Policy

The official working hours of the college are from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM. However, during the final year, students will be posted for internships in various specialty clinics and outpatient departments, where the working hours will be extended from 8:30 AM to 6:00 PM, depending on clinical schedules. A minimum of 80% attendance in each subject and more than 50% marks in internal examination is essential to qualify for every year university examinations

Dress Code & Identity card

Students must attend college and clinical postings wearing the official uniforms and identity card provided by the institution. As they are expected to operate in a professional clinical environment, adherence to a formal dress code is mandatory at all times. Students will not be allowed to enter the college and clinics without the identity card.

Instruments

All students are required to compulsorily possess a retinoscope by the beginning of the second year. It must be carried regularly during all clinical postings, hospital visits, and practical sessions.

Log book

Students are expected to maintain a log book for all the practical and clinical sessions they attend with relevant details. The log book should be submitted whenever asked and before the examinations.

Leave

Students are advised to give prior information to the college authorities about their leave/ permission failing which strict disciplinary action will be taken. Medical Certificate need to be produced from a Registered Medical Practitioner in case of leave availed for more than 2 days.

Holidays

As prescribed by the Government of Kerala / KUHS from time to time.

Sunday Postings

As part of their training, students will take part in community out reach programs, including Sunday camps and OPD activities. Attendance is compulsory, and leave will not be granted for students assigned to these activities.

Anti-Ragging & Student Conduct Policy

In alignment with the directives of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and the University Grants Commission (UGC), our institution enforces a zero-tolerance policy towards ragging.

All students and their parents/guardians are required to submit an online anti-ragging undertaking each academic year through the official portal: www.antiragging.in. This affidavit affirms the student's commitment to abstain from any form of ragging and acknowledges the consequences of such actions.

To ensure a safe and supportive environment, the following mechanisms are in place: National Anti-Ragging Helpline: Students can report incidents anonymously by calling the 24x7 toll-free number 1800-180-5522 or emailing helpline@antiragging.in.

Our institution is dedicated to upholding the highest standards of student conduct and ensuring a ragging-free environment. All students are expected to adhere strictly to these guidelines.



PREVENTIVE MEASURES AGAINST RAGGING

PREVENTIVE MEASURES AGAINST RAGGING

According to the Kerala Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1998, 'ragging' means doing of any act by disorderly conduct to a student of an educational institution, which causes or is likely to cause physical or psychological harm or raising apprehension or shame or embarrassment to that student and includes teasing or abusing or playing practical jokes or causing hurt to such students or asking a student to do any act or to perform something which such student will not in the ordinary course be willing to do.

All institutions will have to abide by the directives of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, Dated May 16, 2007 in SLP No. (s) 24295 of 2006 University of Kerala Vs Council, Principal's, Colleges, Kerala & Ors [with SLP (C) No. 24296-99/2004 & W.P. (CrI) No. 173/2006 & SLP (c) No. 14356/2005] and the recommendations approved by the Honorable Supreme Court of India on effective prevention of ragging in educational institutions.

In case, the applicant for admission is found to have indulged in ragging in the past or if it is noticed later that he/she has indulged in ragging, admission may be refused or he/she shall be expelled from the educational institution. It shall be the collective responsibility of the authority of the institution to see to it that effective steps for preventing ragging are taken. Anti-ragging committees and anti-ragging squads will have to be formed to take effective measures against ragging and they should adhere to the stipulations and effectively monitor and comply with the directives. Each of the student of the institution and his/her parents, or guardian are required to submit a combined undertaking at the time of registration/admission in prescribed format which is mandatory for registration / admission.

Fee Refund/Liquidated damages:

Candidates who express their intention not to pursue studies in the para medical college before the last date fixed for closure of admission will be eligible for refund of the 1st year tuition fee and other fees except admission fee. They will be eligible to get back their original certificates handed over to the college at the time of admission. In case of students who leave the college midway, the right of the management for liquidated damages if any, from such students shall be determined by appropriate proceedings before the competent Forum/Civil Court.

As per the Fee Regulatory Committee (FRC) "The college have no right to retain the certificates of the students who may leave the college midway nor to refuse the request for issuance of T. C. Documents shall be released to the applicant- student without any delay. Paramedical College is not entitled to retain the first year tuition and other fees, if the student discontinues the course before the last date of closing of admission stipulated by the competent Forum/ Civil Court.

Proposal for fee enhancement for the year 2025-26 has been submitted to FRC for approval. Any enhancement in fee as approved by FRC will be additionally collected from the students.
